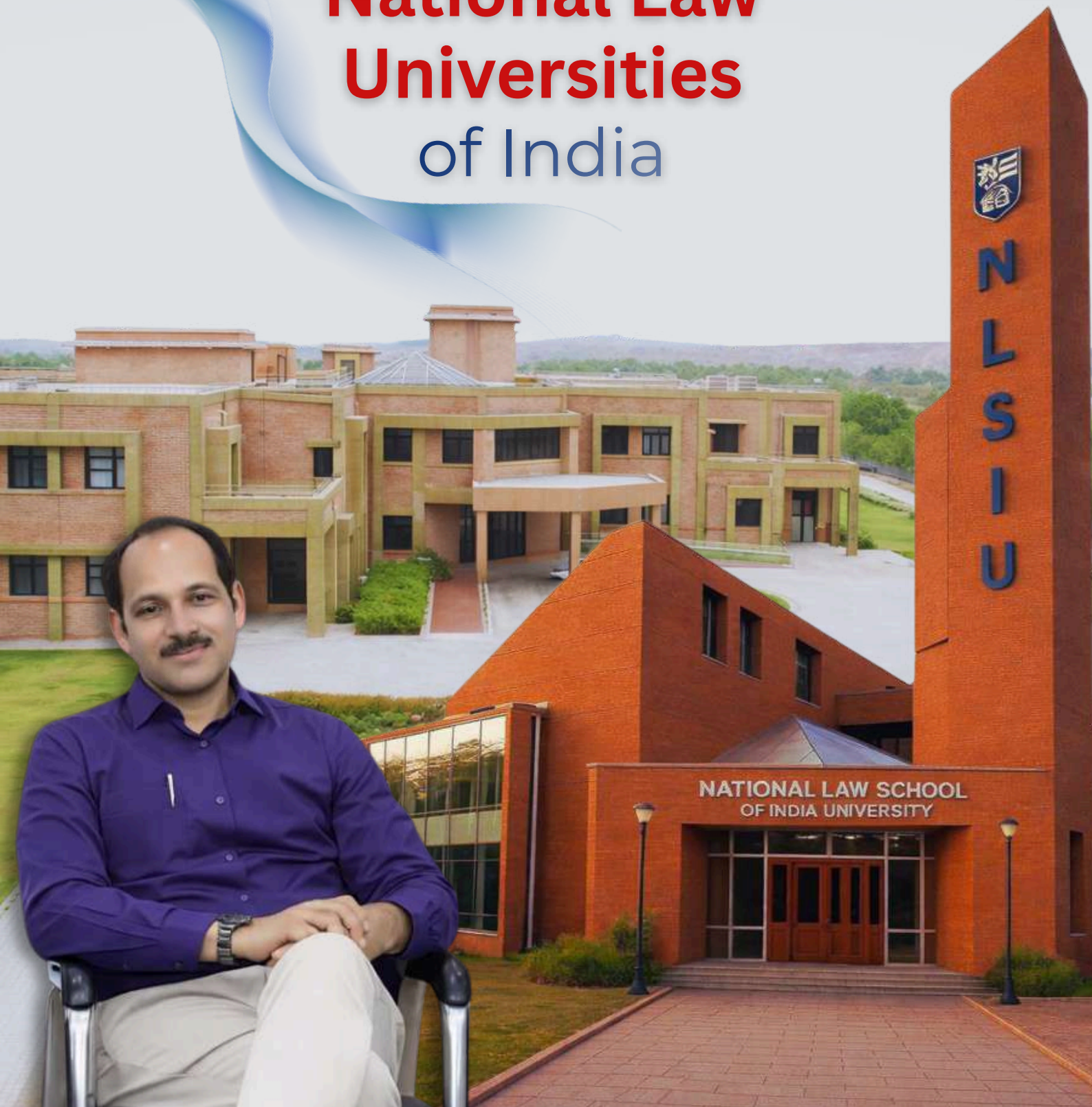

- **Marking:** +1 for correct , -0.25 for incorrect

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List of National Law Universities (NLUs) in India

There are **26 National Law Universities** in India (plus one off-campus at GNLU Silvassa). Most (24–25) participate in the **Common Law Admission Test (CLAT)** for admissions, conducted by the Consortium of NLUs. Exceptions include:

- **NLU Delhi:** Admits via **AILET** (All India Law Entrance Test).
- **NLU Meghalaya:** Uses its own entrance test (MEG UAT/PAT).
- Some newer NLUs may have separate processes for PG programs.

Most NLUs offer:

- **UG:** 5-year integrated programs like **BA LLB (Hons)**, **BBA LLB (Hons)**, etc.
- **PG:** 1-year **LLM**.
- **Other:** PhD, diplomas/certificates (varies).

Fees are approximate annual totals (tuition + hostel/mess; subject to revision). Seats refer to approximate intake for flagship 5-year **LLB**.

CLAT UG Instructions

General Instructions

- The CLAT examination shall be in OFFLINE mode.
- The applications have to be submitted ONLINE only through the website consortiumofnlus.ac.in
- Indian Nationals/NRIs seeking admission to the UG programmes can appear for CLAT.
- Foreign Nationals are not eligible to appear for CLAT. The applicant are advised to refer to the e-brochures as well as the websites of the respective NLUs for more details. These candidates are required to approach the respective NLUs directly for admission.
- For NRI/NRI Sponsored seats, the applicants are advised to refer to the e-brochures as well as the websites of the respective NLUs for more details.

Documents to be uploaded with the online Application

1. Front-facing passport size recent photograph with plain background.
2. Signature of the candidate.
3. Category certificate, if you are applying under SC/ST/OBC category.
4. Relevant certificate issued by the competent authority, if you are applying under PwD category.

NOTE

- The original certificates/documents issued by the competent authority, as specified in the brochure, are to be submitted to the allotted University in the form and manner as specified by the respective universities at the time of admission.
- The photograph and signature of the candidate need not be attested while submitting the Online Application Form.
- All documents/certificates should be uploaded in PDF format only.

Application Fee

- Application fees can be paid online only.
- Application fee for General / OBC candidates: Rs. 4,000/-
- For SC / ST / BPL / PwD category candidates: Rs. 3,500/-
- Application Fee is non-refundable and non-adjustable.

Admit Card/Hall Ticket

The Admit Card/Hall Ticket can be downloaded by the candidate by logging into his/her account. The exact date on which the hall tickets will be made available will be intimated on the website.



CLAT UG EXAM ELIGIBILITY

- There is no upper age limit for candidates appearing for UG Programme for CLAT .
- Candidates who have passed 10+2 or an equivalent examination with a minimum of:
 - Forty-five percent (45%) of marks or its equivalent in grade;
 - Forty percent (40%) of marks or equivalent in case of candidates belonging to SC / ST / PwD categories.
- Candidates appearing for the qualifying examination in March / April 2027 are also eligible to apply.



CLAT UG Syllabus

Introduction and Overview

The UG-CLAT will focus on evaluating the comprehension and reasoning skills and abilities of candidates. Overall, it is designed to be a test of aptitude and skills necessary for legal education, rather than prior knowledge, though prior knowledge may occasionally be useful to respond to questions in the Current Affairs including General Knowledge section.

The UG-CLAT shall be a 2-hour test, with 120 multiple-choice questions, carrying 1 mark each. There shall be negative marking of 0.25 marks for every wrong answer.

These questions would be divided across the following five subjects:

- English Language
- Current Affairs, including General Knowledge
- Legal Reasoning
- Logical Reasoning
- Quantitative Techniques

English Language

In this section of the UG-CLAT, you will be provided passages of about 450 words each. These passages will be derived from contemporary or historically significant fiction and non-fiction writing, and will be of a standard that a Class 12 student may be able to read in about 5–7 minutes.

Each passage will be followed by a series of questions requiring candidates to demonstrate their comprehension and language skills, including their ability to:

- Read and comprehend the main point discussed in the passage, as well as any arguments and viewpoints discussed or set out in the passage
- Draw inferences and conclusions based on the passage
- Summarise the passage
- Compare and contrast different arguments or viewpoints set out in the passage; and
- Understand the meaning of various words and phrases in context that they are used in the passage.

Current Affairs Including General Knowledge

In this section, you will be provided passages of up to 450 words each. The passages will be derived from news, journalistic sources and other non-fiction writing. The questions may include to the passage, but would not require any additional knowledge of the law beyond the passage.

Each passage will be followed by a series of questions that will require you to demonstrate your awareness of various aspects of current affairs and general knowledge, including:

- Contemporary events of significance from India and the world
- Arts and culture
- International affairs
- Historical events of continuing significance

Legal Reasoning

In this section, you will be expected to read passages of around 450 words each. The passages may relate to fact situations or scenarios involving legal matters, public policy questions or moral philosophical enquiries. you will not require any prior knowledge of law to attempt the questions in this section. you will benefit from a general awareness of catemporary legal and moral issues better apply general principles or propositions to the given fact scenarios.

Each passage would be followed by a series of questions that will require candidates to:

- Identify and infer the rules and principles set out in the passage
- Apply such rules and principles to various fact situations
- Understand how changes to rules or principles may alter their application

Logical Reasoning

The Logical Reasoning section will include short passages of about 450 words each. Each passage will be followed by one or more questions requiring candidates to:

- Recognise an argument, its premises and conclusions
- Identify the arguments set out in the passage
- Critically analyse patterns of reasoning
- Assess how conclusions depend on premises or evidence
- Infer what follows from the passage and apply inferences to new situations
- Draw relationships and analogies, identify contradictions and equivalence, and assess the effectiveness of arguments

Quantitative Techniques

The Quantitative Techniques section of the UG-CLAT will include short sets of facts or propositions, or other textual representations of numerical information, followed by a series of questions.

you will be required to derive information from the passages or questions, and apply mathematical operations on such information.

The questions will require candidates to:

- Derive, infer and manipulate numerical information set out in such passages; and
- Apply various 10th standard mathematical operations on such information,, including from areas such as ratios and proportions, basis algebra, mensuration and staistical estimatin.
